
This is in response to your letter dated July 25, 2007.

In my letter to you dated July 20, 2007, I advised you that you may wish to inquire of the Office of the United States Trustee as to why Mr. Farmer is succeeding Mr. Nicholson as trustee in your bankruptcy case. That advice stands.

To the extent that the purpose of your letter dated July 16, 2007, was to notify the court of the error in the notice dated July 5, 2007, identifying Mr. Nicholson as the successor trustee, that clerical error was discovered and a corrective notice dated July 12, 2007, was sent to creditors and parties in interest in your case.

To the extent that you wish to object to the appointment of Mr. Farmer as successor trustee, you should file an appropriate motion to bring the matter before the court. The court generally does not enter correspondence such as letters on the docket and will take no action unless a written motion has been filed. I notice that you filed such a motion (Docket No. 164) when you objected to the appointment of Mr. Nicholson as a successor trustee.

If you do wish to file this type of motion, you will also need to obtain a hearing date and provide notice of the hearing date and time to parties in interest. You may obtain a hearing date in advance by contacting the courtroom deputy at (808) 522-8100.
