Please accept this as the first notice of new claims made in the referenced case alleging racketeering, tax fraud, mail fraud, wire fraud, conspiracy to commit fraud, breach of attorney-client privilege, conflicts of interests, obstruction of justice, and other wrongful acts.

"I WOULD REQUEST THAT MR. TSUKAZAKI RELEASE TO ME A COPY OF ANY SIMILAR LETTERS SENT TO HIM, MS. TIUS, OR BISHOP ESTATES. I BELIEVE WE SHOULD ALL COOPERATE IN EXCHANGING SUCH INFORMATION FOR OUR MUTUAL BENEFIT AND THE PRESERVATION OF OUR CARRIER'S INTERESTS."
